Did you know that ...



a hotel guest can consume on average between 100 and 200 gallons of water per day, which equals approximately **73,000** gallons of water by room, each year.



in 2018, several international hotel chains used a total of



38.8% of hotels have a water-saving system in place, mainly used for shower installations.

Features of a sustainable hotel



• WATER - Water-saving devices are installed in faucets and water tanks



AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS - Promotes lower water consumption, which applies for guests and hotel staff



LIGHTING - Replacing fluorescent tubes with LED technology in common areas, rooms, exterior areas, signs, etc.



SMART AIR CONDITIONING - Reduces unnecessary use of air conditioning by 50%, using a smart programmable system
